

## Teaching in Canada?

Are you an Internationally Educated Teacher (IET)? Don't know where to begin?

**Pathways to Teach Canada** helps internationally educated teachers (IETs) begin teaching in Canada. It is a new centralized system that evaluates international teaching credentials across Canada. Once you're approved through Pathways, your information is passed on to the relevant Provincial/Territory Teacher Regulation Branch (TRB).

Launched in November 2024, Pathways to Teach Canada is a single-entry point for internationally educated teachers interested in teaching in participating provinces and territories in Canada. Pathways to Teach has partnered up with WES. But teachers still need to go through Pathways, not directly to WES for their teaching certificate.

The provinces that don't work with Pathways to Teach Canada are Alberta, Yukon and Quebec. Ontario only accepts the Language Credentials. So, teachers will have to apply directly to the province's Teacher Regulation Branch. But all this information is on Pathways website.
